It is the student's responsibility to access the site and to be aware of all assignments, deadlines and test dates. I reserve the right to pop quiz on any given day of class on any topic taught.

For the students in Honors Algebra I, Honors Algebra II and Honors Pre-Calculus, the file box of the current unit is always due on the test day. The file cards should be a thorough and accurate summary of the current unit. This year long project must always be complete, i.e., I will not accept file cards of the current topic if they are not in the designated file box and are not part of the continuous file of units.

The date given on the web site is the date on which the homework is assigned, therefore, not the day on which it is due. Each assignment is due on the subsequent class day unless it is a test day. Then the assignment would be due at the next class meeting or unless otherwise indicated. Each assignment is graded according to the following criteria:

- 1) clear labeling
- 2) punctuality
- 3) effort on each problem i.e., every problem must be recorded (with the exception of applications), appropriate work displayed.

Calculator answers are unacceptable unless requested or are the logical conclusion to the question.

- 4) answers checked when answer key is provided
- 5) labeled with a ratio indicating number correct out of total.

AP Calculus AB is required to maintain a portfolio throughout the course.

The Portfolio assignments are due on the date indicated on the web site. Design a cover for your portfolio due with the first assignment. Assignments for the portfolio, must be typed, hole-punched, attached to a quarter poster board and will be evaluated on the following:

Thoroughness, attention to detail, correct and adequate use of terminology, legibility and accurateness of examples, grammar, spelling, & timely submission.
